



Valley of the Winds – Community Consultative Committee Nominations Invited for Community Representatives

Nominations are invited and will be received by the undersigned up to 4.00 pm on Thursday April 1 2021 from community members, within the Coolah-Dunedoo area, for the appointment of five community representatives to the Valley of the Winds wind farm Community Consultative Committee (CCC).

We are looking for a mix of people who live locally or are members of a stakeholder group (community, environment, Aboriginal or industry) to join the CCC. Your role as a committee member is voluntary. Appointments to the committee will be determined by the Secretary, NSW Department of Industry, Planning and Environment.

The Valley of the Winds wind farm Community Consultative Committee will comprise eight members - five community members, two representatives of Warrumbungle Shire Council and a representative of the proponent.

The committee provides a forum for open dialogue between the proponent and representatives of the local community, stakeholder groups and local council on issues related to the project.

As a committee member you will be expected to contribute constructively to committee discussions, attend around four meetings a year, and communicate information about the Valley of the Winds Project from the committee to the broader community.
