

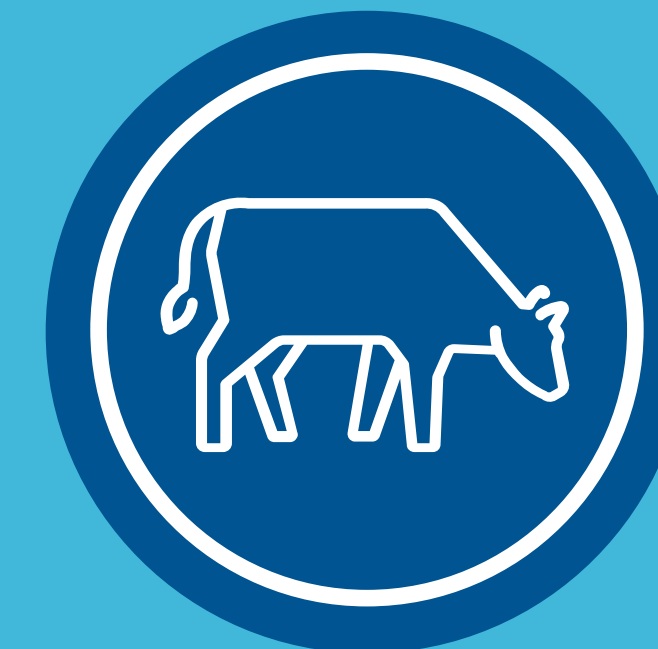


Project Benefits

Voluntary Planning Agreement (VPA)
